



Notice on Edinburg Routes

Valley Metro routes servicing **Edinburg** will soon be modified to connect with the **Edinburg Transit Terminal**, which is due to open late September 2020. The terminal, which is located near the Hidalgo County Courthouse on University Drive, will serve as a transfer point that will enable a greater number of passengers to access destinations across the Rio Grande Valley.

Anticipated changes will impact the following routes:

- **Route 10** (Edinburg – McAllen)
 - Start and end at the Terminal, segment east of the terminal will be deleted.
- **Route 12** (La Villa – Edcouch – Elsa – Edinburg – Weslaco)
 - Add a regular stop at the terminal.
- **Route 14** (UTRGV VABL)
 - Add a regular stop at the terminal.
- **Route 15** (Edinburg North)
 - Add a regular stop at the terminal and interline with route 30.
- **Route 16** (Courthouse Circulator)
 - Add a regular stop at the terminal.
- **Route 30** (Pharr – San Juan – Edinburg)
 - Add a regular stop at the terminal and interline with route 15.
- **Red Line 3** (RGV Metro Express)
 - Add a regular stop at the terminal.

Route 10 will start and end at the terminal. All the current stop locations on other routes listed above will remain unchanged—the routes will now simply feature an added stop to the Edinburg Transit Terminal, which may result in a slight alteration to the scheduled times.
